Information on Form LCPC 5.7 Waiver of Reimbursement

- 1) A paid-in-full funeral bill must be provided at the time of filing. We will no longer allow them to file the case and provide the bill later when they file a Commissioner's Report.
- 2) The paid funeral bill must show who actually paid the bill, not just who the bill was sent to. If it's not apparent who paid the bill, we also need to ask the applicant if they used their personal funds or estate assets for payment or if the bill was prepaid.
- 3) If the bill was paid by someone other than the applicant, there must be a Waiver of Right to Reimbursement from each person, other than the applicant, who helped pay the bill. If waivers are not included, reimbursements should be shown on the Assets and Liabilities form and on the Entry Relieving Estate from Administration.
- 4) If the applicant provides a copy of the contract showing that they have obligated themselves to pay the funeral bill, a debt to the funeral home must be listed on the Assets and Liabilities form and on the Entry Relieving Estate from Administration.
