The Local Rules of Practice for the Probate Division of the Lucas County Court of Common Pleas are hereby ordered amended and adopted pursuant to Rule 5 of the Rules of Superintendence for Courts of Ohio effective July 20, 2009 to include the following changes.

These rules supplement Rules 50-99 of the Rules of Superintendence for the Courts of Ohio and must be read in conjunction therewith.

Rule 58.1
COURT COSTS

- A. Deposits in the amounts set forth shall be required in the following actions and proceedings, including those where the fiduciary is bonded:

I. Fee—Special Projects Funds


Pursuant to R.C. 2302.202(E), the Court has determined that, for the efficient operation of the court, additional funds are necessary to acquire and pay for special projects of the court, including, but not limited to, the acquisition of additional facilities or the rehabilitation of existing facilities, the acquisition of equipment, the hiring and training of staff, community service programs, the employment of magistrates, the training and education of judges and magistrates, and other related services.

A Special Projects fund fee of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) shall be collected on the filing of each civil action or proceeding, decedent's estate, (full administration only), wrongful death, trust or minor settlement.

A Special Projects fund fee of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) shall be collected on the filing of each guardianship.

IT IS THE ORDER OF THIS COURT THAT THIS AMENDMENT TO THE LOCAL RULES IS EFFECTIVE JULY 20, 2009.
